

DRAFT Telephone Conversation/Meeting Summary

Boston Logan Airport Noise Study Logan International Airport

S. Smith asked about the meeting format. G. Lattrell said the last meeting was a presentation followed by a question and answer session. F. Leo believes that a presentation is important. There was some discussion on the presentation. F. Leo discussed the kinds of questions representatives asked. R. Dormitzer has alerted Garret Bradley, the State Representative for Hull, Hingham, and Cohasset. S. Smith offered a note taker from The Planner's Collaborative if available.

F. Leo cannot make the March 15 date. There was some discussion on changing the meeting date to March 14. F. Leo will attempt to change his plans so he can make himself available on March 15. The meeting will be assumed for that date until the PMT hears back from F. Leo.

Cumulative Noise Update:

S. Smith reported that Wyle has one more quality check to perform. Once that is done, they will send the noise results to the IC for their review. Results expected to be forwarded to IC for review tomorrow.

Phase 2 BOS/TAC & CAC meeting:

S. Smith suggested that the beginning of April would be a good time for the first meeting, rather than the end of March. J. Falbo will be unavailable the first part of April. Volpe is the preferred meeting site. S. Kunz asked G. Lattrell whether she can follow up on using Volpe for CAC meetings. G. Lattrell will do so. She believes that a representative of a federal agency needs to be present for meeting held at Volpe.

There was some discussion on the BOS/TAC leadership and how it may change during Phase 2. Further discussion was had on the cumulative noise findings and how they should be presented. There was also some discussion on how best to present findings. S. Smith suggested to J. Falbo that the CAC allow the IC to decide on how best to present information. F. Leo asked how information is presented to the FAA. S. Smith said the IC will update the matrix they created.

There was some discussion on impact thresholds, including DNL and determinations that a project is highly controversial on environmental grounds. Tina Gatewood and S. Smith explained what this means.

Discussion turned to the cumulative noise effects review. R. Dormitzer stated that it is important to have this information for the March 15 meeting. G. Lattrell thinks there is enough information already available to get everyone up to speed. J. Falbo thinks that Gail needs to be prepared to answer all questions. F. Leo asked S. Smith coordinate cumulative effects review with the IC. PC did not commit that the cumulative analysis would be completed by March 15th, but would coordinate with IC to determine potential.
